

Gloucestershire Airport Announces 3 Season Extension of Down Hatherley Cricket Club Sponsorship.

Gloucestershire Airport has confirmed that it will be extending its sponsorship of Down Hatherley Cricket Club until 2014. The Airport is currently in its third season of sponsorship with the club, and is delighted with the progress that has been made within the club since 2009.

Amongst their progress, the club has enrolled in the ECB Clubmark scheme, which is an accredited scheme that produces a high quality community cricket club.
