

Cranes

If you need to operate a crane at a height of 10 metres (approx 32.8ft) or more, within a 3.7 mile (6km) radius of the aerodrome, you should advise Gloucestershire Airport of the following:

- The exact location of the crane (including address and postcode) and/or an OS grid reference;
- The maximum operating height in metres Above Ordnance Datum (AOD), or the height of the crane Above Ground Level (AGL) plus ground level in AOD. Note: heights Above Ordnance Datum (AOD) are those shown on Ordnance Survey maps as Above Mean Sea Level (AMSL);
- The type of crane/equipment (e.g. Tower Crane, Mobile Crane etc);
- The radius/height that the jib/boom will extend to and the area of operation of a mobile crane;
- The intended dates and times of operation; and
- Your name and contact details/contact details for the operator on site during lifting.
